Feiba vwd f9 and Novo has been in short supply through support from HFI Thane chapter, Chennai we have treated critical patients some have survived but we lost few to brain bleeds like Suraj our EC member which was sad this prompted us to take a fresh perspective on clinical trials.

We have been instrumental to disseminate knowledge on trials on inhibitors which has resulted in higher recruitment as well as more clinical trial centre in Mumbai . Today we have about 12 patients on Hemlibra and 10 on Futistarian this has helped improve the life of inhibitors patients.

However the enrollment of trial by patients is there independent personal decision.

We have tried to open centers at Borivali, Sion hospital and JJ hospital which we hope to become functional with there own resources in years to come especially JJ hospital which has shown strong inclination.

KEM has been backbone and continues to remain with aid from GOM , HFI and dedicated doctors.

To end the future is bright and we hope to have in the next year the Gene therapy program for Mumbai patients.

The Dept of Dentistry KEM Hospital has actively started treating Hemophilia patients since 2012. Along with Hemophilia patients Dental management of patients with other Bleeding disorders and factor deficiencies is also done.

Initially we started managing only Emergencies, active bleeding from teeth , gums, trauma. We have now moved on to Definitive management. Extractions, Fillings, Root Canal treatment, Dentures Partial and Complete and Crown and Bridges. Multiple extractions are done at a time with a proper protocol, X-rays and Pre-OP factor replacements. Post op factor replacements are done if required. Extreme care is taken to minimize excessive bleeding and majority of patients have no postoperative complications.

Once the patient enters the dept a proper Treatment planning is done and followed.

Patients are also advised about proper Oral hygiene maintenance, so that they can improve ORAL HEALTH which in turn improves Nutrition and General Health.

Special attention is given to children with Hemophilia where full mouth rehabilitation is done in selective patients under general anaesthesia which facilitates entire Dental treatment to be done at one go.

The dept of Dentistry KEM Hospital has now moved on from handling only Emergency Dental Treatment to Restorative and Rehabilitative Dental treatment, with special Emphasis on Prevention of Dental Disease. The patients who used to initially fear dental treatment have now gained confidence and are convinced about our dental care and now follow up regularly with the Department.

Carrier detection in hemophilia A and B

In the current year 111 females (83 haemophilia A, 27 haemophilia B and 1 factor VII females) were referred for the detection of carrier status. The analysis was performed by inverse PCR for intron 22 and 1 inversion in F8 and direct sequencing of the coding regions of the respective genes. 51 females were found to be carriers whereas 59 females were non carriers. One of the females was found to be homozygous.

2 VWD families were referred to us for prenatal diagnosis; both the fetuses were unaffected. Markers used for diagnosis were Intron 40 VWD VNTRS.

Prenatal diagnosis in case of FVII (n=2), FXIII deficiency (n=1) and Afibrinogenemia (n=1) was offered using direct sequencing technique. All the fetuses were found to be unaffected except one FVII family.

Major Projects:

Save One Life (SOL)

Save One Life was founded in 2000 by Lauren A. Kelley, author, president of LA Kelley Communications and mother of a son with hemophilia. We have been receiving help under Sponsorship Programme, Scholarship Fund, Micro-Enterprise Fund and Project Share since many years.

This year, under Sponsorship project total 34 from Mumbai beneficiaries received donation. Fund received total USD \$ 9161 (Rs. 6,31,012/- Approx). This help means a lot to Hemophiliacs which was used for various needs like education, food, medicine, celebration and public transportation.

Received Rs.65,192/- (\$ 895) for Sumeet Kasbe (Factor – VIII) for studying Bachelor degree in Animation and VFX under Scholarship Program.

During the distribution, we informed all the beneficiaries about the various schemes of Save One Life i.e. Sponsorship, Scholarship, Micro Enterprise grant etc. in detail, for e.g. the eligibility, criteria, age group, documents, grants under various schemes etc.

Nurses Project:

This project is meant for those patients, who require occupation therapy. Patient who goes to therapist and after scrutinizing the patient, when therapist advise to undergo occupation therapy, then to avoid such patient's everyday travelling and unnecessary muscular pain, we have planned to initiate this project.

Under this project, therapist goes to patient's house and gives regular therapy rather than patient comes to hospital. This saves not only patient's daily travelling and bleeding but also helps them to concentrate fully only on their therapy during that time span. This project will save further joints damage of the patients.

The Society has started the Nurses Project in October, 2011 with the fund support received from Valentine Trust of United Kingdom and donation received from Dr. Alison of U.K. from time to time. The initiative to start this project was taken by Dr. Alison, Dr. Devila Sahu, Ms. Indira Nair and Mr. Zulkef Colombowala. From last two year Mr. Chetan Motivaras is taking care of this project along with the assistance of KEM Occupational Therapist Dr. Jaysree Kale and Dr. Kirti Kene Patil.

The Project ran for about 8 years from October'2011. This year under this project on an average 13 therapist doctors have supported for 124 home visits during this period. The total fund spend on this project was about Rs. 62,800. The society will revive this project on receipt of further funds.

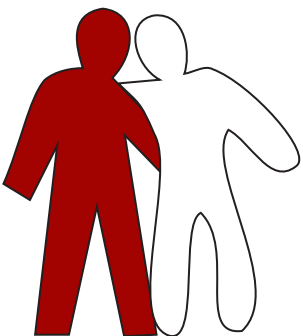
