### Carrier Detection in Hemophilia A and B & Other Bleeding Disorder :

In the current year 65 females (58 Hemophilia A, 6 Hemophilia B, 1 Factor VII females) were referred for the detection of carrier status. The analysis was performed by inverse PCR for intron 22 and 1 inversion in F8 and direct sequencing of the coding regions of the respective genes, NGS and MLPA.

**40 females were found to be carriers whereas 25 females were non carriers.**

### First trimester antenatal diagnosis of Hemophilia A and B by chorionic villus sampling procedure:

In the current year, Genetic diagnosis of 8 Hemophilia A patient referred to us from various centers in India was successfully carried out. In the current year, total 40 females were referred to us for first trimester antenatal diagnosis of Hemophilia A, B, VWD. 30 females belonging to hemophilia A families and 6 females belonging to hemophilia B families, 2 VWD families were referred in the first trimester for prenatal diagnosis. 31 fetuses were found to be unaffected whereas 7 were affected. Methods used for analysis were same as that used for carrier detection.

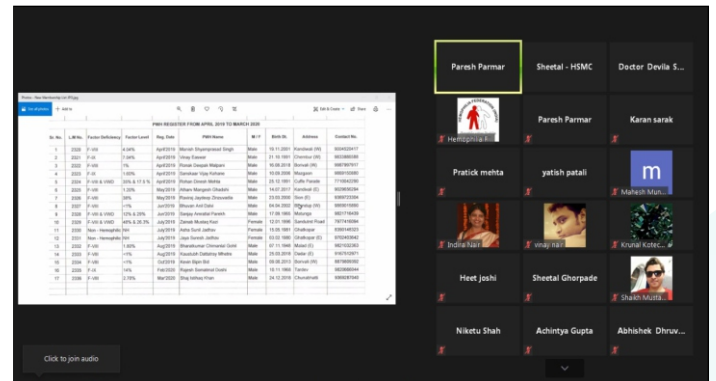
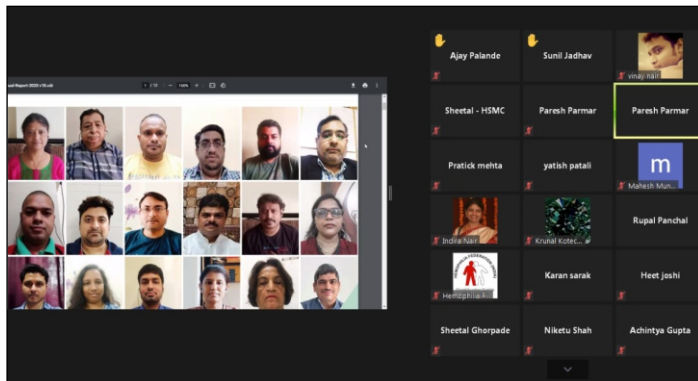

## HFI AGM 2020:

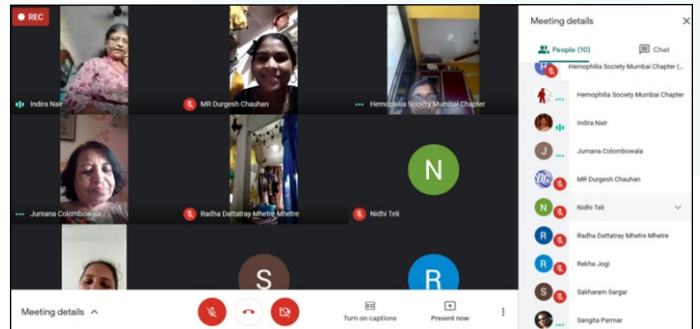

A total of 10 women members attended this meeting with staff on the Virtual Platform.

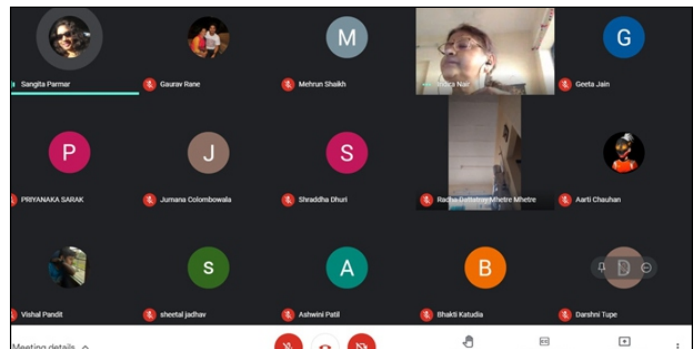

## Save One Life Project:

Save One Life was founded in 2000 by Laureen A. Kelley, author, president of LA Kelley Communications and mother of a son with hemophilia. We have been receiving help under Sponsorship Programme, Scholarship Fund, Micro-Enterprise Fund and Project Share since many years.

This year, under Sponsorship project total 33 from Mumbai beneficiaries received donation. Fund received total USD \$ 9,585.78 (Rs. 7,22,757/- Approx). This help means a lot to Hemophiliacs which was used for various needs like education, food, medicine, celebration and public transportation.

Received SOL scholarship fund of Rs. 12,782 /- (USD \$ 169.51) for beneficiary Lalit Chavan on 18 August 2021.

## Nurses Project:

The project was started in October, 2011. Under this project, therapist goes to patient's house and gives regular therapy rather than patient comes to hospital. This saves not only patient's daily travelling and bleeding but also helps them to concentrate fully only on their therapy during that time span. This project will save further joints damage of the patients.

This year under this project on an average 9 therapist doctors have supported for 142 home visits during this period. The total fund spend on this project was about Rs. 68,750.
