

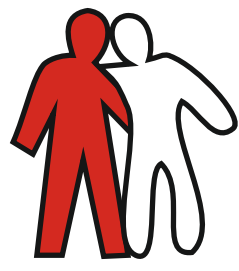

Carrier Detection in Hemophilia A and B & Other Bleeding Disorder :

In the current year 85 females (77 haemophilia A, 8 haemophilia B) were referred for the detection of carrier status. The analysis was performed by inverse PCR for intron 22 and 1 inversion in F8 and direct sequencing of the coding regions of the respective genes, NGS and MLPA. 49 females were found to be carriers whereas 36 females were non carriers.

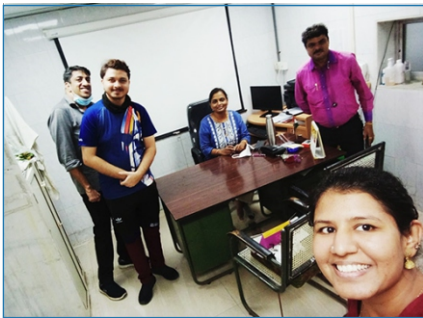
Diwali Gift Distribution:

Major Projects:

Save One Life (SOL)

Save One Life was founded in 2000 by Laureen A. Kelley, author, president of LA Kelley Communications and mother of a son with hemophilia. We have been receiving help under Sponsorship Programme, Scholarship Fund, Micro-Enterprise Fund and Project Share since many years.

This year, under Sponsorship project total 33 from Mumbai beneficiaries received donation. Fund received **total USD \$ 12265.48 (Rs. 8,37,506/- Approx)**. This help means a lot to Hemophiliacs which was used for various needs like education, food, medicine, celebration and public transportation.

Received SOL scholarship fund of **Rs. 51,730/- for beneficiary Aakash Rane** on 23.02.2022, **Rs. 15,090 /- for beneficiary Lalit Chavan** on 29.03.2022, **Rs. 23,046/- for beneficiary Mohit Tiyan** on 10.06.2022, **Rs. 25,721/- for beneficiary Shakir Shaikh** on 25.08.2022. **Total received SOL scholarship fund of Rs. 1,15,587/-**

Home Therapy Project:

This project is meant for those patients, who require physical therapy. Patient goes to therapist and after scrutinizing the patient, when therapist advise to undergo physical therapy, then to avoid such patient's everyday travelling and unnecessary muscular pain, we have planned to initiate this project.

Under this project, therapist goes to patient's house and gives regular therapy rather than patient comes to hospital. This saves not only patient's daily travelling and bleeding but also helps them to concentrate fully only on their therapy during that time span. This project will save further joints damage of the patients.

This year under this project on an average **7 therapist doctors** have supported for **44 home visits** during this period. The total fund spend on this project was about **Rs. 21,300**.
